## Woodworker's Mill Features

### Easy Maintenance

The Woodworkers Mill is rustproof – all parts are weather resistant. The sawmill is constructed out of anodized aluminum, stainless steel bolts, and nylon slides.

### Ergonomic Design

This mill is designed with the operator in mind. Everything is at the right height for operation without back strain.

### Strong Construction

Made of anodized extruded aluminum, this mill is extremely strong for it's size, easily supporting and lifting over ten times its weight.

### Lightweight

The Woodworker's Mill weighs only 85 pounds. It is easily transported to the site by trailer or in the back of a truck, or easily moved to the tree for on-site milling.

### Safe to Operate

The chain pulls the wood against the bed, firmly holding it in place while cutting.

### Independent Log Bed Suspension

Provides the ability to produce tapered cuts and angle cuts.

### Smooth Cuts

The surface of the lumber cut with the Woodworker's Mill is so smooth that it can be finished with a belt sander. And with the ease of log handling and positioning using the independent log bed suspension, you can maximize the cutting of the log to produce the best lumber.

### Unique Low Profile Ripping Chain

Easy to sharpen ripping chain has a narrow 1/4" kerf. Life span is approximately 3000 b.f. of lumber.

### Cuts all Diameter of Logs

The low profile chain is available in 16", 20", and 25" cutting lengths, and even longer bars with larger chains can be added to handle those extra large logs. Logs too large to place on the sawmill can be cut by mounting the sawmill to the log.

### Expandable to all log lengths

Extensions are available to easily add the necessary length to process longer logs.

## OBTAINING FREE LOGS

Resources (usable logs) are available free in your community. Call your local tree trimmers, parks dept. and city arborist for a start. Many times, tree trimming professionals will deliver logs to you, free of charge, that they have removed from city streets or private premises simply to get rid of them. Pulp wood purchasers are another source and will often sell valuable logs for a very good price.

Sawmills will often sell short or unique logs for a fraction of their value. Its easy to find yourself with too many logs, and you will discover that specifying your needs to the tree trimming professionals works the best. Tell them specifically what kind of wood you are looking for and that you will purchase any logs of those types when they become available.

The more people you talk to, the more resources will become available to you, and sometimes, show up on your doorstep!
